Supporting Pastoral Training in Cuba

The goal of the Cuba Methodist Seminary Fund is to support the work of the Methodist Church in Cuba's through training Pastors effectively for ministry.

There are currently 119 students at the Havana Seminary. It takes six years of study to graduate from the Seminary (two years in the district extensions and four years in the Havana Seminary) completing 164 credit hours. The Seminarian is both a pastor and a student during this time.

There are 34 district theological seminaries throughout the Island (each Methodist district has one seminary with some having more than one). There are 1,700 students and 324 professors in the extensions.
